

Dogs on Leads Perranporth Beach Order 2011

The Clean Neighbourhood and Environment Act 2005

The Dog Control Order (Prescribed Offences and Penalties, etc.)

Regulations 2006 (SI.2006/1059)

The Dogs on Leads Perranporth Beach Order 2011

The Perranzabuloe Parish Council hereby makes the following Order

- 1. This order comes into force on 30th of June 2011
- 2. This order applies to the land specified in Schedule 1

Offence

- 3. (1) A person in charge of a dog shall be guilty of an offence if, during the times and periods specified in Schedule 2, on any land to which this Order applies he does not keep the dog on a fixed lead of not more than 6 feet in length, unless –
- (a) He has a reasonable excuse for failing to do so: or
- (b) The owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally or specifically) to his failing to do so.
- (2) For the purpose of this article a person who habitually has a dog in his possession shall be taken to be in charge of the dog at any time unless at that time some other person is in charge of the dog.

Penalty

4. A person who is guilty of an offence under article 3 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.

SCHEDULE 1

The land to which this order applies is that part of Perranporth Beach bounded:-

- on its southern edge by the Promenade and cliffs to Droskyn Point
- on its eastern edge by the South West Coastal Path from the Promenade to Flat Rocks
- on its western edge by the sea (as far as the line of lowest astronomical tide)
- on its northern edge by a straight line in a west north westerly direction from the foot of the steps at Flat Rocks to the sea

The land is shown edged red on the Plan attached to this Order

SCHEDULE 2

The times and periods to which this order applies are:-Every year on all days between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. from and including the 1st of July until and including the 31st of August.
