



## Minutes – Full Council

### Minutes of the virtual extraordinary meeting held at 6.30pm on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2021

**Public Participation** – There were no members of the public present. Cllrs agreed to a closed meeting

#### **55/21/FC Apologies**

Apologies had been received from Cllr Silvey who was unwell.

#### **56/21/FC Declarations of interest and dispensations granted**

Cllr Arthur declared an interest and would abstain from the vote.

#### **57/21/FC Exclusion of press and public due to confidential nature of the matter to be discussed**

Members agreed to the exclusion of press and public.

#### **58/21/FC Football Event – Discuss Inflatable Theme Park Event application**

Cllrs White and Byfield requested that it be recorded that the Parish Clerk had strongly advised against the proposal due to the seriousness of several accidents involving similar inflatable facilities which had resulted in harm and fatality to members of the public. The council's insurance company had advised against proceeding with the event.

Concerns were raised by members that the level of Public Liability Insurance being provided was inadequate.

Concern was raised over lack of clarity regarding the identity of the Operator, the Hirer and the Contractor.

Concerns were raised over lack of clarity on the Application documents as to venue, dates and responsible persons connected with the event.

Cllr Byfield proposed that all concerns about Insurance, Hire and Operations Contractors raised by members, be raised with the football club. These would need to be addressed in writing and the matter would then be considered again at a further meeting. Proposal AGREED.

There being no further business the Chairman closed the meeting at 19.07 hours
