Metal Detecting Policy

Perranzabuloe Parish Council recognises that metal detecting is a popular hobby that can result in helping us gain a greater understanding of our past.

The Council is aware that you don't need a licence to use a metal detector in the UK, however, there are laws about their use.

Using a metal detector is illegal on private land without permission from the owner.

Metal detecting on land owned or tenanted by Perranzabuloe Parish Council is not permitted except where a metal detecting survey is part of an approved archaeological investigation.

This policy applies to everyone, whether they are members of metal detecting clubs, amateur archaeologists, students, academics, professional archaeological companies or private individuals. The Council have taken this approach as it believes it is the best way to continue to look after our local environment.
